The John Davidson Educational Trust (the Trust) will fund Postgraduate students in the fields of **Engineering and Accounting ONLY at Post Graduate Diploma, Honours and Masters level**. Please note that unrelated courses will not be considered.

To be eligible students must show academic suitability and financial need. (N.B Section 3.3 must be completed in detail.) The bursary, if awarded, is for 2022. It cannot be rolled over to the following year.
